THE TRAINING

The training aims to help school managers with responsibility for lunchtime to:

- ❖ Implement excellent whole school practice in relation to lunchtime.
- ❖ Identify the training needs of the lunch time supervisors.
- ❖ Develop clear systems to include lunchtime supervisors, and to improve communication between them and other staff members.

It offers the lunchtime supervisor team 5 hours of school based training to develop:

- ❖ Strategies and skills to communicate with and to manage children's behaviour effectively.
- ❖ A clearer understanding of their role within the school staff group.
- ❖ Increased self- esteem and professionalism.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES


There is an obvious advantage in offering training to Lunchtime Supervisors and other support staff, so creating a happier and safer playground and dining-hall environment. My training methods are flexible and the sessions are engaging and enjoyable.

The groups are evaluated, and specific goals for the future are identified.

The package includes:

- ❖ A preliminary meeting with the Headteacher to discuss the content of the training and the particular needs of the school.
- ❖ Five hours of training, arranged at times to suit the Lunchtime Supervisors.
- ❖ A meeting with the Lunchtime Supervisors and the Headteacher at the end of the training to decide on action points.
- ❖ A certificate for each participant.
- ❖ A copy of my book – The Handbook of Lunchtime Supervision- to enable further development of lunchtime practice.
