

Communicating with Children and Managing Behaviour – for Improving Schools

School-based training for Lunchtime Supervisors

THE TRAINING

This training is developed especially to enable schools in special measures or deemed to be in need of improvement to develop high quality lunchtime practice. The training aims to help school managers with responsibility for lunchtime to:

- ❖ Implement excellent whole school practice in relation to lunchtime.
- ❖ Identify the training needs of the lunchtime supervisors.
- ❖ Develop clear systems to include lunchtime supervisors, and to improve communication between them and other staff members.

It offers the lunchtime supervisor team 5 hours of school based training to develop:

- ❖ Strategies and skills to communicate with and to manage children's behaviour effectively.
- ❖ A clearer understanding of their role within the school staff group.
- ❖ Increased self-esteem and professionalism.

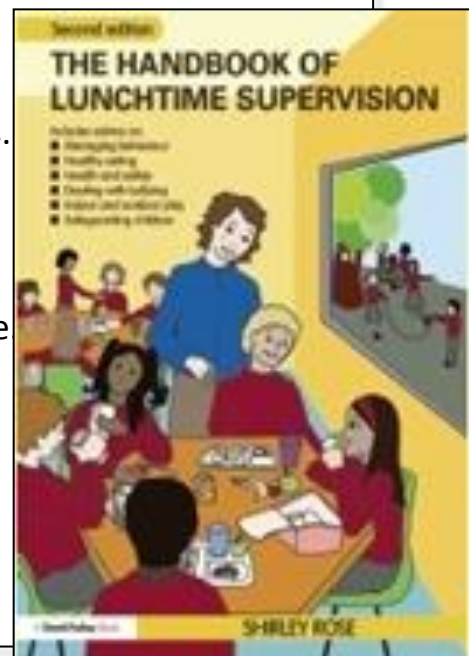
LEARNING OBJECTIVES

When lunchtimes are well managed, the afternoon learning is likely to be more successful. Training Lunchtime Supervisors will help to ensure well behaved pupils and safer playground and dining-hall environments. My training methods are flexible and the sessions are engaging and enjoyable. The groups are evaluated, and specific goals for the future are identified

The package includes:

- ❖ A preliminary meeting or call with the senior manager to discuss the content of the training and school's particular needs.
- ❖ Five hours of training, arranged at times to suit the Lunchtime Supervisors.
- ❖ A meeting with the Lunchtime Supervisors and their manager at the end of the training to agree on action points for the future
- ❖ A certificate for each participant.
- ❖ A copy of my book – The Handbook of Lunchtime Supervision- to enable further development of lunchtime practice.

The cost is £475.00 plus travel expenses outside of London.
