School-based training for Primary School Lunchtime staff

THE TRAINING

The training helps school managers with responsibility for lunchtime to:

- ❖ Implement excellent whole school practices to enable lunchtime staff to manage pupil's behaviour, with particular emphasis on SEND pupils.
- ❖ Identify the training needs of the lunch time supervisors.
- ❖ Develop clear systems to include lunchtime supervisors, and to improve communication between them and other staff members.

It offers the lunchtime supervisor team 5 hours of school based training to develop:


- ❖ Strategies and skills to communicate with and to manage children's behaviour effectively.
- ❖ A clearer understanding of their role within the school staff group.
- ❖ Increased self- esteem and professionalism.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

There is a great deal that schools can do to support children with SEND at Lunchtime. This requires creative thinking and careful planning to ensure systems are in place to minimise disruption and to enhance positive lunchtime experiences. The session will offer lunchtime staff the chance to understand the needs of the pupils they work with and to respond with skill and flexibility.

The package includes:

- ❖ A preliminary discussion with the Headteacher to discuss the content of the training and the particular needs of the school.
- ❖ Five hours of training, arranged at times to suit the Lunchtime team.
- ❖ A meeting with the Lunchtime Supervisors and the Headteacher at the end of the training to decide on action points.
- ❖ A certificate for each participant.
- ❖ A copy of my book – The Handbook of Lunchtime Supervision- to enable further development of lunchtime practice.
